

How does a team get in a certain league and/or night?

After registration closes for the upcoming season, the Adult Program Manager reviews all the registrations to form leagues and then meets with a committee of 3-5 members to review, discuss, and finalize the team placements. Teams are first placed into a league/night using the following criteria:

1. First priority is given to teams playing in the most current season that have requested the same league and night.
2. Second priority is given to teams playing in the most current season that have requested a different league and/or night.
3. Third priority is given to teams that are new or are not playing in the most current season
4. Fourth priority is given to teams that registered after registration closed (no matter if they are new or returning).

If two teams meet the exact same criteria, priority is given to the team that registered first.

Once initial placement has been determined, a team's record (as it stands on the date registration closes) is reviewed. The rise and fall rule is used and adjustments to league team placement might be made in order to keep the leagues as competitive as possible while making every effort to keep a team on the same night they requested. Any league changes that differ from a team's initial request is reviewed and discussed by the Placement Committee to make sure the move is appropriate for the team.

Teams are then contacted when the Adult League Manager and Placement Committee have placed all teams. Once all teams have been notified and leagues are finalized, the team bids for the 7/8pm playing slots (if applicable) are reviewed and leagues are scheduled accordingly.
